# Three Reasons to Become a Community Coach

## 1. You make a real difference in your community.

Over 95% of YRP program participants have not reoffended. That is **600% below the average** rate of recidivism for inmates returning to Yavapai County.

## 2. You have a positive impact on a person's life.



"The Yavapai Reentry Project was out there to help [reentering individuals] and get us back into the community. Knowing that that was out there was a relief."



"The Yavapai Reentry Project offered me a sense of direction and gave me a feeling of purpose. It gave my family a sense of serenity to know that there was an organization willing to help me even though I had—well because I had a history in prison!"

## 3. You help shape the lives of children.

Children who have a parent who has been imprisoned have a better than 50% chance of going to prison themselves.

Helping re-establish healthy family relationships for an ex-offender helps *reduce those chances*.
